

Woolwell Table Tennis Club are holding an Open Day & 24 hour "Marathon" from 9am on Saturday 3rd July to 9am on Sunday 4th July 2010.

A maximum of eight tables will be available for play and there will be a spectator area.

Non members are particularly welcome to attend all of, or any part of, the day's activities. The event is intended to provide fun and excellent competition for club members and visitors alike, and to raise money for club funds.

The Club's Annual Award Ceremony will take place at 4.30pm between the two competitions. It will be followed immediately by a free buffet. All who attend the club (whether playing on the day or not) and their families, together with all our visitors to the Open Day, are cordially invited to attend. In place of the normal raffle a short Auction of Promises will take place following the Award Ceremony. Donations of lots for the auction will be accepted in advance or on the day.

All standards of play will be catered for in both the singles event and fun event. Both are open to all ages and playing abilities as well as both sexes.

Every player in the singles will be guaranteed at least six matches with consolation and beginners events ensuring that everyone gets plenty of play at their own standard. There will be trophies for all finalists. Full details of the fun event will be available on the day. **Entries for the Open Singles will close on Wednesday 30th June 2010.** Entries will not be accepted on the day for this event but you can enter the Fun Event up to 15 minutes before the scheduled starting time.

Free hot and cold snacks and drinks will be available during the day on Saturday to players and spectators. Free breakfast will be provided on Sunday morning for those staying all night.

Woolwell Table Tennis Club is now a registered Community Amateur Sports Club. It can obtain a tax refund worth an extra 25% for all donations gift aided. This is at no extra cost to the donor so we hope everyone will encourage their sponsors to donate money in this way. **All that is needed is a name, address, details of the donation and confirmation that the sponsor is a UK taxpayer.** Non gift aided donations can be included on the same form.

Completed sponsorship forms with money should reach John Smith by Monday 12th July 2010.

All players, whether staying for the full 24 hours or just part of the "Open Day", can choose to obtain sponsorship from their friends and/or families or pay the relevant fees. Entry fees are waived for those raising at least £20 in sponsorship money. We would expect those staying overnight to raise at least this amount to cover the costs involved. For every £5 pledged over £20 participants will receive a £2 voucher to spend at the Auction of Promises.

No access to, or exit from, the Centre will be allowed between 10.30pm on Saturday and 8.30am on Sunday except in real emergencies. Tables will be available for practice and it is hoped to provide at least one table tennis robot for use during this period. The Centre has plenty of parking space, washing and changing facilities, and basic sleeping facilities will be available for those not brave (or foolhardy!) enough to stay up all night. At least one adult of each sex will be in attendance throughout the entire period. Any parents who wish to accompany their children overnight will, of course, be welcome to do so free of charge.

Entry forms should be submitted with the correct money (retain the remainder of this leaflet for information) to the Tournament Organiser, John Smith. Cheques should be made payable to Woolwell Table Tennis Club. If a stamped addressed envelope or e-mail address is provided then entries will be acknowledged.
